Matching statements

CDM 2015	Applies to all construction work carried out in Great Britain
Notifiable project	10 workers on site for 60 days (domestic or commercial)
Designer	An organisation or individual that prepares or modifies a design for any part of a construction project
Principal contractor	Prepares the construction phase plan when there is more than one contractor
Pre-construction information	Provides the basis for preparation of the construction phase plan
Designer/s, contractors, Principal designer, principal contractor	A domestic design and build project with 3 contractors carrying out the work. Which duty holders are recognised?
Health and safety file	Contains relevant health & safety information to be taken into account during any subsequent work
Principal designer	Plans, manages and monitors the pre-construction phase
Key elements to securing health and safety in construction	Everyone has the information, instruction, training and supervision they need to carry out their jobs
All duty holders	Who should co-operate, communicate and co-ordinate?
Not notifiable	A project scheduled for 38 construction days with 10 workers on site for the duration
Where there is only one contractor	Health and safety file not required
Construction phase plan	A record of the health and safety arrangements for the construction phase
Domestic client	Their duties are normally transferred to either the contractor or principal contractor
All projects	Require a construction phase plan
Client (commercial)	Retains overall responsibility for managing the health & safety of a project
Construction work	Alteration, conversion, renovation, repair, maintenance, demolition.....
A contractor	An individual, sole trader, self employed worker or a business that carries out, manages or controls construction work
